The Port of Corpus Christi Authority (PCCA) is currently accepting bids for Security Grant 7 Northside Security & Critical Docks Access Control. Bids for this project must be submitted in duplicate and in a sealed envelope addressed to Port of Corpus Christi Authority, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401, Attention: Greg Brubeck, P.E. Bids must be received at this address by September 28, 2010, 2:00 PM, at which time, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders must submit with the Bid a bid bond, cashier's check, or certified check for not less than 5% of the maximum amount of the Bid (Base Bid and all Additive Bid Items). The bidder must also complete and attach a Bid Breakdown Sheet to the Bid unless otherwise indicated in the Special Conditions. The bid will be deemed non-responsive if any item is blank. Bids may not be faxed to the PCCA office.

Base Bid scope of work consists of installing a security gate, with asphalt parking, concrete paving, lighting, cameras, access control, fencing, gates, active net barrier system, concrete barriers, modular metal building and covered inspection area. Additive Bid Items include driver license scanners, K-4 crash rated gates, concrete barriers and active net barrier system.


Potential bidders will be furnished one set of Contract Documents free of charge; additional sets may be obtained for the nonrefundable amount of \$45 per set. Subcontractors desiring a set may obtain one for the same nonrefundable fee. This is a lump sum contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are required when the successful bidder executes the contract, each for 100% of the total contract price, unless the contract amount is less than \$25,000, in which case no Payment or Performance Bond is required and no partial progress payments will be made. If the contract price is greater than \$25,000 but less than \$100,000, a Payment Bond only will be required. For contracts greater than \$100,000, both Payment and Performance Bonds will be required.

A pre-bid conference (attendance is strongly encouraged) will be held at the PCCA Administration Building first floor conference room at 222 Power Street at 9:00 a.m., September 16, 2010. Bidders should report to the PCCA Project Manager, Mr. Pat Veteto, P.E., and proceed to the project site as a group.
