

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Port of Corpus Christi Authority (PCCA) is currently accepting bids for **MODIFICATION OF COFFERDAM FENDER SYSTEMS AT OIL DOCKS 4 & 7**. Bids for this project must be submitted in duplicate and in a sealed envelope addressed to Port of Corpus Christi Authority, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401, Attention: Greg Brubeck, P.E. Bids must be received at this address by 2:00 P.M., September 30, 2009, at which time, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders must submit with the Bid a bid bond, cashier's check, or certified check for not less than 5% of the maximum amount of the Bid (Base Bid plus all possible combinations of Additive and Alternate Bid Items). The bidder must also complete and attach a Bid Breakdown Sheet to the Bid unless otherwise indicated in the Special Conditions. Bids may not be faxed to the PCCA office.

Scope of work of this project generally includes removal and replacement of mooring levels, removal and replacement of cylindrical fenders with connection hardware, selective demolition of upper portion of existing cofferdam structures, and installation of new dock fender systems at Oil Docks 4 & 7.

Potential bidders will be furnished one set of Contract Documents free of charge; additional sets may be obtained \$15.00 per set. Subcontractors desiring a set may obtain one for the same nonrefundable fee. Contract Documents may be obtained at the address listed above or by calling the PCCA Engineering Department at 361-885-6167.

This is a lump sum contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are required when the successful bidder executes the contract, each for 100% of the total contract price, unless the contract amount is less than \$25,000, in which case no Payment or Performance Bond will be required and no partial progress payments will be made. If the contract price is greater than \$25,000 but less than \$100,000, a Payment Bond only will be required. For contracts greater than \$100,000, both Payment and Performance Bonds will be required.

A pre-bid conference (attendance is strongly encouraged) will be held at PCCA Administration Building at 222 Power St., Corpus Christi, TX, Thursday, September 24, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. Bidders should report to the PCCA Project Engineer Jacob Morales and proceed to the project sites as a group.
