

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
OIL DOCK 9 ALLISION REPAIRS
PORT OF CORPUS CHRISTI AUTHORITY

The Port of Corpus Christi Authority (PCCA) is currently accepting bids for **OIL DOCK 9 ALLISION REPAIRS**. Bids for this project must be submitted in duplicate and in a sealed envelope addressed to Port of Corpus Christi Authority, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401, Attention: Greg Brubeck, P.E. Bids must be received at this address by April 30, 2010 at 2:00 p.m., at which time, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders must submit with the Bid a bid bond, cashier's check, or certified check for not less than 5% of the maximum amount of the Bid (Base Bid plus all possible combinations of Additive and Alternate Bid Items). The bidder must also complete and attach a Bid Breakdown Sheet to the Bid unless otherwise indicated in the Special Conditions. Bids may not be faxed to the PCCA office.

Repairs to Oil Dock 9 including the installation of nine 24" dia. pipe piles, construct concrete pile caps, grout cracked beams, dock house repairs along with additive bid items for a new barge breasting structure and a new dock house.

Potential bidders will be furnished one set of Contract Documents free of charge; additional sets may be obtained for the nonrefundable amount of \$30.00 per set. Subcontractors desiring a set may obtain one for the same nonrefundable fee. Contract Documents may be obtained at the address listed above or by calling the PCCA Engineering Department at 361-885-6167.

This is a lump sum contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are required when the successful bidder executes the contract, each for 100% of the total contract price, unless the contract amount is less than \$25,000, in which case no Payment or Performance Bond is required and no partial progress payments will be made. If the contract price is greater than \$25,000 but less than \$100,000, a Payment Bond only will be required. For contracts greater than \$100,000, both Payment and Performance Bonds will be required.

This project will be partially funded with insurance claims, which will require special conditions to be met.

A pre-bid conference (attendance is strongly encouraged) will be held at PCCA Administration Building at 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, TX, April 22, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. Bidders should report to the PCCA Project Manager, Jacob Morales and proceed to the project site as a group.
