

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS  
OIL DOCK NO. 6 FENDER UPGRADES  
AND BREASTING/MOORING STRUCTURE REPLACEMENT

The Port of Corpus Christi Authority (PCCA) is currently accepting bids for OIL DOCK NO. 6 FENDER UPGRADES AND BREASTING/MOORING STRUCTURE REPLACEMENT. Bids for this project must be submitted in duplicate and in a sealed envelope addressed to Port of Corpus Christi Authority, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401, Attention: Greg Brubeck, P.E. Bids must be received at this address by February 3, 2012 at 2:00 P.M., at which time, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders must submit with the Bid a bid bond or cashier's check for not less than 5% of the maximum amount of the Bid (Base Bid plus all possible combinations of Additive and Alternate Bid Items). The bidder must also complete and attach a Bid Breakdown Sheet to the Bid unless otherwise indicated in the Special Conditions. Bids may not be faxed or e-mailed to the PCCA office.

The project generally consists of an upgraded barge fender system at Oil Dock 6. The scope of work for the upgraded fender system includes demolishing the existing timber and composite pile fender system, driving new piles, and constructing a fender mounting system. The work involved for the breasting structure replacement includes demolition of the existing three-pile structure just west of Oil Dock 6 and utilizing the new barge fender system as its replacement.


Potential bidders will be furnished one set of Contract Documents free of charge; additional sets may be obtained for the nonrefundable amount of \$15.00 per set. Subcontractors desiring a set may obtain one for the same nonrefundable fee. This is a lump sum contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are required when the successful bidder executes the contract, each for 100% of the total contract price.

Bidders should report to the PCCA Project Manager David L. Krams, P.E. and proceed to the project site as a group.
