

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS FOR
OIL DOCK 4 SHIP FENDER SYSTEM REPAIRS
PORT OF CORPUS CHRISTI AUTHORITY**

The Port of Corpus Christi Authority (PCCA) is currently accepting bids For **OIL DOCK 4 SHIP FENDER SYSTEM REPAIRS**. Contract Documents may be obtained from David L. Krams, P.E., Director of Engineering Services, at the address listed below. Potential bidders will be furnished one set of Contract Documents free of charge. Subcontractors desiring a set may obtain one for a nonrefundable fee of \$10 per set. Potential bidders may obtain additional sets for the same non-refundable fee of \$10 per set. Registered vendors can obtain a set through the PCCA's procurement website at www.ebidexchange.com/pocca.

Scope of work generally includes replacement of fender rubber elements and fender panels for two ship breasting structures at public Oil Dock 4 including the fabrication of structural steel adapter plates to accommodate the rubber fender elements. Rubber fender elements and fender panels will be supplied by PCCA.

This is a lump sum contract. Bidder must submit a bid bond or cashier's check for not less than 5% of the maximum amount of the Bid (Base Bid plus all possible combinations of Additive and Alternate Bid Items). Performance and Payment Bonds are required when the successful bidder executes this contract, each for 100% of the total contract price.

A pre-bid conference (attendance is strongly encouraged) will be held at PCCA Administration Building, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401 at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 27, 2017. Bidders should report to the PCCA Project Manager, Jacob Morales, and proceed to the project site as a group.

One (1) original and two (2) signed copies of the Bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Bid for **OIL DOCK 4 SHIP FENDER SYSTEM REPAIRS** – Bid Opening 2:00 p.m., Friday, October 6, 2017" and must be addressed to Port of Corpus Christi Authority, 222 Power Street, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401, Attention: Lynn Angerstein, Manager of Procurement Services.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the time bids are due. Bids may not be faxed or emailed to the PCCA office. Bids submitted by express mail service must be in a sealed envelope inside the express mail packaging. The PCCA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids received.
