**SAIL SOUTH TEXAS 2010 WEATHER UPDATE RELATED TO  
TROPICAL STORM ALEX**

**CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS** – The four tall ships scheduled to be at the Sail South Texas tall ship event July 1 – 5, 2010 at Port of Corpus Christi Ingleside Facility (former U.S. Naval Station Ingleside) are experiencing temporary delays due to tropical storm Alex. All four ships are still confirmed to be part of Sail South Texas 2010 but remain berthed in Veracruz, Mexico and report they are expecting a 24 hour delay before departing for Ingleside.

The Sail South Texas Executive Committee is closely monitoring the storm and at this time is still planning on hosting the event. There is likely to be delays to the event and ship viewing schedules pending the arrival of the tall ships from Veracruz.

The committee will be posting event updates throughout each day as more information on the storm and the event schedule becomes available.
